

Cookie Policy

CubeX Industries Ltd - Corporate Policy

This Cookie Policy explains how the CubeX Industries Ltd website may use cookies and similar storage or access technologies. Cookies are small files or identifiers stored on, or accessed from, a user's device to enable website functions, remember choices, measure use or support other features.

Categories of cookies

- Strictly necessary cookies: used for essential functions such as security, load balancing, session management or remembering a user's cookie choices. Consent is not normally required where the legal exemption applies.
- Preference/functionality cookies: used to remember optional choices or improve convenience. These may require consent depending on the purpose and legal exemption available.
- Analytics cookies: used to understand how visitors use the website and improve performance. Where consent is legally required, they will not be set before consent.
- Marketing or third-party cookies: used for advertising, tracking across services or embedded third-party features. Where used, these are enabled only where an appropriate consent or other legal basis applies.

Consent and controls

- Where consent is required, CubeX will provide clear information and a mechanism allowing users to accept or reject relevant non-essential cookies.
- Users should be able to change or withdraw cookie choices through the website consent controls where implemented, and may also manage cookies in their browser settings.
- Refusing optional cookies should not prevent access to the core website, although some non-essential features may not operate as intended.

Third-party services and cookie list

- Third-party services embedded in the website may set their own cookies or similar technologies. Their operation is governed by the relevant provider's terms and privacy information.
- CubeX should maintain an up-to-date cookie scan or consent-platform list showing the cookie name/provider, purpose and duration for each non-essential cookie actually deployed on the live website.

Legal framework

- This policy is intended to reflect the Privacy and Electronic Communications (EC Directive) Regulations 2003 (PECR), the UK GDPR and Data Protection Act 2018, as amended by the Data (Use and Access) Act 2025.
- UK law now provides limited additional exceptions for certain low-risk storage and access technologies, but strictly necessary and consent requirements remain purpose-specific. The live website configuration must therefore be checked against the current ICO guidance.
